

**Required Equipment List**

(1) Heavy duty handgun (9mm, 10mm, 40 cal. and/or 45 cal.) with visible sights- stock handgun sights on all modern firearms work. Tritium sights are not a requirement.

(3) Factory- issued magazines- I'm a big fan of using factory issued magazines, unless you are carrying a 1911.

(1) Quality belt mounted or paddle- type magazine carrier or pouch- Blade Tech, Don Hume, GALCO, Safariland, Comp-Tac, Alien Gear, or any of the other well known Kydex carriers.

(1) Quality belt mounted or paddle-type holster- Again, any of the distributors mentioned above will work just fine.

**Suggested Handguns**

I'm not telling you that you must go out and purchase one of the weapons listed below. The list is just a reference point for your own purposes.

1. **Glock** -any of the mid to full size models and calibers
2. **Smith and Wesson**- M&P series, 1911 clones
3. **Springfield Armory**- 1911 clones, XD series (mid to full size models)
4. **Kimber**- any mid to full size 1911 model
5. **Sig Sauer**- P220, P226, P227, P229, M-11 A1, 1911
6. **Beretta**- 92 series, M-9 A3, 96 A1, P x 4 Storm
7. **Remington**- any mid to full size 1911
8. **Kel Tec**- P-11, PF-9
9. **Heckler and Koch**- P30, VP9, VP40, HK- 45, P2000, and the USP
10. **Browning**- 1911 and High Power series
